FULL-SERVICE CAMPGROUND

THE COMPANY STORE - This is the "nerve center" for Songer Whitewater, the check-in point for your whitewater rafting trip and camping. The expanded Company Store is where you will find souvenirs, trip photos, videos, heated changing rooms, showers, administrative offices and it is our social gathering place! Our 3,000-square-foot deck is where you can relax with friends and relive the days adventures while watching your video. Grocery basics such as ice, soft drinks, snacks, beer, charcoal, personal items, etc., are available. The souvenir shop carries a wide variety of tees, sweats, jackets, fleece, shorts, Columbia Sportswear® and many other items.

TENT CAMPING - Songer's on site campground is a full service facility offering tent sites, both wooded and open-meadow. All sites have an area to build a fire, but contain no grills, and firewood is available for purchase. For your convenience there are two modern bathhouses offering restrooms, hot showers and electrical outlets. Tent rentals are available - damage deposit required. **Pets are allowed in our campground but must be kept on a leash.**

BUNKHOUSE - Groups desiring a camping experience without the hassle of setting up tents may enjoy the convenience of our rustic bunkhouses. At our facilities we have 2 bunkhouses, sleeping 12 people each. Both bunkhouses have covered porches and offer wooden platform style bunk beds and electrical outlets. Bathhouse is located close by. **You must bring your own sleeping pad or air mattress, sleeping bag and pillow.**

CAMPING CABINS - Songer has 7 rustic cabins that sleep 1 to 4 rafters. 4 cabins are equipped with 2 double beds, 2 cabins have 2 sets of bunkbeds, and 1 cabin has 1 double bed, a small table, electricity and air conditioning. Cabins are in walking distance to our headquarters and shower houses. Bring pillows, sleeping bags or sheets and blankets. Damage deposit required. No pets inside of cabins.

ACTIVITIES

In our campground we offer several activities. The most popular is our 9-hole Disc Golf Course. Disc Golf is played like ball golf but with flying discs (aka frisbees) instead of balls and clubs. Scoring is similar also ... one point is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. Completion of the hole occurs when a disc comes to rest in the metal pipe cage basket. The object is to acquire the lowest score (without cheating)! Our course design includes fairways, doglegs and certain places where trees and posts have been left and players must go around the left or right side of the obstacle to approach the basket. Also, water hazards and the natural mountain terrain of our area add to the fun!

Our activity center also includes volleyball and horseshoe pits.

Discs can be purchased, and horseshoes and volleyballs can be rented in The Company Store!
