**F** **Canyon Rim Visitors Center:** Picnic area, museum exhibits and videos. Boardwalk offering scenic views of the Gorge. Six hiking trails and a biking/hiking trail are within 5 miles. 304-574-2175

**F** **New River Gorge National Park:** Over 60 miles of trails, good roads and 4 visitors centers.

**\$** **Hawks Nest State Park:** Gift shop, museum, aerial tramway, scenic overlooks and jetboat excursions. 1-800-CALL-WVA

**F** **Babcock State Park:** Tour the operating Glade Creek Grist Mill. Great scenery and hiking. 1-800-CALL-WVA

**\$** **Sarge's Snorkeling & Swimming Charters:** Half day outings on Summersville Lake.

**\$** **Summersville Lake:** The beach at the Lake is great for kids and adults! Beach is free - \$1 per adult to park.

**\$** **Exhibition Coal Mine:** Go underground on a man-trip car pulled by a battery powered locomotive. Witness primitive and modern mining techniques on this 35 minute underground tour. One room schoolhouse and superintendent's house also available for touring. 304-256-1747

**\$** **Youth Museum:** Log cabin, barn, schoolhouse, moonshine still, blacksmith shop and country store. Hands-on exhibits and planetarium. (Adjacent to Exhibition Coal Mine) 304-252-3730
